COVID-19 Safety Precautions at EGP Camp

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Encounter God's Presence ministries are taking many extra precautions to keep everyone safe.

- EGP is in compliance with the guidelines for the safety of our campers and leadership provided by the State of Texas and also Southwestern Assemblies of God University (SAGU).
- We are not fearful but believe God gives us faith along with wisdom to walk in.

 Extensive measures have been enacted by SAGU and EGP to help prevent any infection or spread of any sickness. EGP camp will include medical professionals: a Nationally Registered Emergency Medical Technician, a Medical Assistant and Registered Nurses who will help keep on eye on everyone's health and well-being.
- Before groups arrive, they are required to take every person's temperature, confirm no one is sick or has been around anyone with Covid-19.
- <u>Daily routines of temperature checks</u> on all teenagers and adults will be standard procedure at camp. Anyone with a temperature of 100 or more will be quarantined for 2 hours and another temperature reading will be taken to check the validity of the 1st reading.
- Optional <u>face masks</u> are encouraged unless Texas Governor Abbott's guidelines increase and are determined to be required.
- **Social distancing** is encouraged. There will be limited mixing between groups. **Housing** will have 2 beds per room and extra space provided during sessions.
- The **dining facility** is more than adequate to provide extra space needed.
- <u>Hand washing</u> of 20 seconds (time it takes to say The Lord's Prayer) will be regularly expected. <u>Hand sanitizer</u> will also be available.
- SAGU commits to additional surface sanitation of all main contact points.
- After camp, all campers should be cautious with the possible enhanced risks of being in direct contact with anyone age 65 or older for 14 days.
- We expect the campers to come healthy, have an amazing camp experience and return home physically healthier and more spiritually passionate than they have ever been before.
- We encourage everyone to let the peace of God rule our hearts and minds through Christ Jesus as we **pray a Psalm 91 hedge of protection** over all of us.

In addition to the waiver that's on the camp registration form, all campers and adults must sign this special form on the next page releasing EGP ministries and personnel from any liability if there's any sickness that they may consider was contracted during EGP camp.
