## **Instructions for Consent to Travel**

Anyone under 18 that's not traveling with <u>both</u> of their parents needs to have an international letter of consent signed by parents and <u>have it notarized</u>. Even if one parent will be travelling with the minor, the Letter of Consent needs to be signed by the other parent just in case they ask for it.

Once you do this please send us a copy. You wouldn't actually sign it until you are with a notary. It needs to be signed & **notarized within 30 days of travel**. Usually your bank will have a notary and may provide this service free to their costumers. Thanks,
