

### STUDENT GUIDELINES



# AT CAMP DEVO #1 "He is I AM"

Main Verse: Exodus 3:14

Bonus Verses: John 6:35, 8:12, 10:7-11, 11:25, 14:6, 15:5

The story of Moses is awesome. Moses saw an ocean part and thousands of people walk across it on dry land, water coming from a rock, food appearing out of nowhere every day, and so much more. He even had a conversation with a bush. Moses had messed up, He felt alone and unwanted. We've probably all felt that way sometimes. His failures and feelings did not cancel God's amazing plans for him. God caused a bush to suddenly be on fire, but it wasn't consumed. From the bush God spoke to Moses, it got Moses' attention. In that moment God told Moses that He still had amazing things planned for him, but Moses wasn't sure. Finally, he said, "Who should I say sent me? What is your name?" Great question. God told Moses to tell the people, and us, He is I AM. The children of Israel were surrounded by a polytheistic people. The Egyptians had different gods for everything, It had to be confusing. God wanted them to know that He is enough.

Challenge: Today, God wants us to remember the same thing. No matter where you are in your walk with God, no matter what you've done, what you need, what fears you have – God is enough.

Today's prayer: Almighty God, You are enough. Help me to rest my heart in this truth today. I choose to give You my hopes and dreams, my pains and worries. It's all Yours. Your grace is enough. You will provide. You will heal. You will direct. Everything I need is found in You. You are really enough.

# AT CAMP DEVO #2 "Think Outside the Box"

Main Verse: Ephesians 2:10

Bonus Verse: Psalm 139:14

Have you ever heard the phrase, "Think outside the box"? It simply means to approach something in a different way. Have you ever thought about applying that to your relationship with God or how you think about yourself?

If we are not careful, we can put God into a box. Yes, God is everywhere. However, in our minds we can create pictures of what God can or will do. We may start to believe that God should do something in a way that we understand or can predict. But God will never fit in our boxes. That's a good thing! He is capable of infinitely more.

Also, we need to not put ourselves or those around us in boxes. We may allow the enemy to speak to us and define us by perceived weaknesses and failures. He points to our box, and too often we just get in. But God doesn't have boxes. He has placed more inside of you than you know, He is excited to unleash the greatness that He has placed in you. Ephesians 2:10 declares, "you are God's masterpiece". He has created you to be a new creation. It's time to listen to the voice of The One who has created and redeemed you. Allow Him to tell you who you really are. It is time to think outside the box.

Today's prayer: God, I thank You that You are truly a God with no limits. There is nothing You can't do. Yet, You choose to want a relationship with me. Heavenly Father, I ask that You silence the lies of the enemy that tell me that I am not enough, that I don't measure up. I thank You that You have created me and called me a masterpiece. I am the work of Your hand. I choose today to listen to Your voice and believe what You say.

# AT CAMP DEVO #3 "Fear Not"

Main Verse: 1 John 4:18

Bonus Verses: 2 Timothy 1:7, Isaiah 41:10

Have you ever seen the old movie "Monsters, Inc"? In the movie the monster's town is powered by the fears of children. Our enemy works kinda the same way. The more that he can keep us in fear the more power he seems to have over us. The good news is that Jesus has already won that battle!

We all have fears from time to time. The Bible teaches that the way to overcome fear is not to just try harder, but that we can overcome fear by knowing that it is not from God (2 Timothy 1:7), that God is always with us (Isaiah 41:10) and that the powerful love of God will drive out fear (1 John 4:18). The love of God is and will always be more powerful than what might have you afraid. God wants to exchange your fear for His peace today!

**Today's prayer**: Jesus, I thank You that fear does not come from You. I ask in Your name that You drive away any fear from my heart, my home, my school, my church and everywhere else I go. Please empower me today with Your love and Your peace.

# AT CAMP DEVO #4 "Time to Worship"

Main Verse: Psalm 100:2

Bonus Verses: John 4:24, Romans 12:1

Year after year when asked about the best part of EGP camp, the worship always is at or near the top. It's so awesome! There is nothing like gathering in a room full of people who love Jesus and are pouring their heart out to Him and getting to see Him respond in mighty ways. Great news: We aren't done yet! God has more in store for us. With God there is always more!

We should also remember that worship is not simply the songs we sing. Worship is our response to God; It's expressed in how we love and serve others. Worship is expressed in our devotion to God. Worship is not a thing we do, it should be an expression of who we are. Singing songs is great, The Bible encourages us to do so, "Worship The Lord with gladness, come before Him with joyful songs." Main Verse: Ephesians 3:20


Bonus Verse: Ephesians 6:10

# AT HOME DEVO #5 "Go"


Main Verse: Matthew 28:19


