## **Passport Information**

Here's some info we've put together last year, more details can be found on their websites.

How and where you apply depends on when you need your U.S. Passport.

Need to get a passport or renew yours?

Please do it now. We have had people that drug their feet, kept putting it off and had to miss the trip.

You need to jump on it now!

How long will it take to get your passport?

If getting anything done with a passport after Sun. March 26, 2023, we recommend paying more to get it expedited for extra peace of mind.

Last year was... Normally takes 8-11 weeks

If close to that, you should pay to get it expedited, which should take 5-7 weeks.

2023 Update: New normal time 10 - 13 weeks (They warn mail could take 2 weeks extra there and then possibly 2 weeks extra back.) 14 - 17 weeks

**2023 Update: For new expedited time** 7 - 9 weeks (They warn mail could take 2 weeks extra there and then possibly 2 weeks extra back.) **11 - 13** weeks

Passport info.

(If you're not in the DFW area, you'll need locate which is best location near you. Sub-courthouses seem to be the best option.)

## Passport Applications Are Processed By Appointments Only

Call to make an appointment for passport.

**817-202-2968** Press #1 for passports (Lori has been super helpful in the past.)

There's different ones to get, depending on age and if it's a renewal or a 1<sup>st</sup> time passport.

DS-11 (Forms can printed from the state's website to fill out in advance and bring in with you.)

\$190 - passport "book" express mail \$18.32

\*\*\* \$208.32 must be paid w/ a check or money order \*\*\*

(Costs are subject to change.)

\$35 - office fee

\$15 for picture (A dark color shirt is ideal due to the white background.)
(Possible option to do the photo part at home, must follow specific guidelines.)

Pay with cash \$50 or with card it's \$52.50

(Costs are subject to change.)

## **ALL first time passports NEED birth certificate**

(Original or certified copy with raised seal)

(Not one with feet prints, that's a nice little souvenir from the hospital.)

Minor's Consent to Travel is on EGP website

May get notarized at your bank within certain amount of days (or pay at places like Fed Ex or Eagle Postal)

Those under age 18 may have certain things needed.

Age 16 and 17 need one parental consent for passport

Under age 16 need both, if both are listed on birth certificate

(For any unique family situations just call them to discuss it for other options.)

Passports for those under age 16 ...

\$100

\$160 or \$178 with express mail

DS -11 is for kids 5 years and under

Adults not more 5 years, dc-82, mail new photo, check, priority mail, for expedite

Late additions - You can call and check with them to confirm you will have enough time, hopefully they will be able to get them done sooner. You would need to schedule an appointment asap because those fill up. You'll want to pay to have it expedited just to be safe please.

(There's even situations that IF you can get an appointment at the super busy Dallas office, they can do it there, when you can prove your trip is within 14 days. More details below.)
