### STUDENT GUIDELINES

# AT CAMP DEVO #1 "Changing my mind"

### Bible verses:

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God - this is your true and proper worship. <sup>2</sup>Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - His good, pleasing and perfect will. (Romans 12:1-2)

Our brains are fascinating. They have an amazing ability to process information. Neuroscience – the study of the brain – tells us that we can change the way our brains work by the thoughts that we think. It's like changing the default settings. Science says that if you think positively, it rewires your brain to think positively. (The reverse is also true)

The Bible teaches us that the more we focus on the goodness of God the more we will see it. This is not simply trying to think happy thoughts. This mind change is changing the way your mind operates by filling it with the Word of God. The more we immerse our minds with His Word the more clearly we see who He is and who we are. Romans 12:2 says not to be like everyone else around us but to allow the Spirit of God to change us. His desire for us is to be more like Him. He wants to fill our minds with His amazing thoughts. He wants to change our mindset from just thinking of ourselves to focused on Him & His supernatural Kingdom.

Heavenly Father, I thank You for how You made me. There are so many things I think about. You know it all. Help me to think Your thoughts & focus on You & Your will. Please renew my mind as I read Your Word. In Jesus name I pray.

# AT CAMP DEVO #2 "Faith is evidence"

### **Bible Verse:**

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. (Hebrews 11:1)

Recently I had to make a trip to a "big-box store" to return something. (I bought the wrong thing.) This was a really easy process. It was an easy process because I had something proving that I had bought it the first time, it was a little piece of paper called a... yep, you got it – a receipt. That receipt was proof of my earlier purchase.

Believe it or not faith is kinda like a receipt. It is proof that because God has been good before and cannot change, He will be good again. Faith in God's power gives us confidence that even if we don't know what He's doing, that He is working on our behalf to bring about good. # AT CAMP DEVO #3 "What do you want me to do for you?"

### Bible verse:

In Mark 10:51 we find this great account about a guy named Bartimaeus. He was blind and was on the roadside begging. He yelled out for Jesus to stop by and "have mercy" on him. The people around him told him to be quiet. But he yelled even louder. Jesus stopped and asked him, "What do you want me to do for you?" He said he wanted to see, and guess what, Jesus healed him.

The question Jesus asked could seem strange or even rude. What the man needed from Jesus was clear and obvious. But Jesus wasn't trying to embarrass him. Jesus wanted him to ask for what he wanted. The question required him to be bold and have faith that Jesus is who he thought Jesus is.

What do you want Jesus to do for you? Do you believe He can do it? Do you believe He wants to? Choose to believe that He wants to heal your body, or your family or a broken relationship. Whatever you truly need, just ask. He is willing and able. What do you want? When you pray & ask... believe.

### Talk with God:

Jesus, there is nothing You can't do. You're so powerful and have done so many amazing miracles. I'm asking You to heal and to restore these areas of my life. I'm asking You to provide and protect. I trust You will. Thank You for Your love and for meeting this need. You deserve all the glory. In Jesus name I pray.

# AT CAMP DEVO #4 "Limitless"

### **Bible Verse:**

Great is our Lord and mighty in power; His understanding has no limit. (Psalm 147:5)

"I have no idea". Ever said that? Perhaps it was looking at a math problem or when asked to explain an author's meaning for some random paragraph in a story. Perhaps you've also thought this when trying to figure out why something may be happening in your life or in the world. We all face times where our knowledge and understanding is limited.

### **Bible Verses:**

<sup>9</sup>If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup>For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. (Romans 10:9-10)

Jesus is Lord. What do you think that means? The word lord means one who has authority or rulership over another. To say that Jesus is Lord means that we recognize that He has authority. Sounds great, right? But what does that really mean? Jesus is not interested in controlling you. He is interested in you trusting Him. He always leads us in what's best. 
### **Talk with God:**

What's your favorite fruit? No, the pink Starburst is not a fruit. Fruits are good for you. A farmer plants the seeds and waters, and God causes the fruit to grow.


In Galatians 5 Paul is contrasting the works of the flesh and the fruit of the Spirit. The works of the flesh are those things that we do when we listen to our own selfish desires and the voice of the enemy. The fruit of the Spirit is what God produces in us as we walk with Him. As we pray, read His Word, and spend time with Him we become more loving, joyful, peaceful, patient, kind, good, faithful, gentle, and self-controlled. We become more like Jesus. Our life bears the fruit of His Spirit in us, so when people see us, they see Jesus living through us.
