STUDENT GUIDELINES

The week at Encounter God's Presence camp is where God wants to radically change your live. We want to see you receive from God in a powerful way. - No water guns, water balloons, shaving cream fights, or "rough-housing" allowed. Disruptive, destructive, or dangerous behavior is prohibited. You will be responsible for replacement of anything you break.
- There will be no leaving the campus or inviting guests without the approval of your youth pastor and camp leadership.
- Armbands must be worn at all times for identification and security, and will be used as your meal ticket, so please keep them on your wrist.
- 8. This is a university campus with no housekeepers so clean your rooms before leaving each morning. Please make your bed, keep your clothes in or "near" your suitcase, keep all trash picked up, and keep the bathrooms free from clutter and the floors dry.
- 9. We challenge you to not allow romantic relationships or emotions to distract you from what God has for you.





AT CAMP DEVO #1 "One encounter changes everything"

Bible verses:

My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God? (Psalm 42:2)

Extra Bible verses:

Luke 17:11-19

The New Testament is full of stories of people who had their entire lives changed. They received a healing, but more than that they encountered Jesus. In Luke 17 we have an amazing story of Jesus healing 10 lepers. It was a life-changing miracle. But one of them came back to say, "thank You". Jesus says to him that his faith has made him whole. He didn't just have his skin cleared, he had his future changed. He encountered Jesus.

At camp, we have the opportunity to do more than simply have Jesus meet a need (which He is ready and willing to do) or see Jesus do miracles. (He still does those too) We have a chance to truly encounter Jesus. Psalm 42:2 says "My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God?". Jesus wants to meet with us. We have come to truly encounter God, and one encounter changes everything.

Let's pray:

Jesus, I can't wait to see what You're going to do at camp. Thank You in advance for all the awesome things You have planned for us. You are the Healer. I know You're going to change lives forever and help us walk more in our destinies. I'm excited to be able to spend more time with You. My soul does long for You. Help me to truly encounter Your presence more and more. I pray all this in Jesus' name.

AT CAMP DEVO #2 "I will meet you on the other side"

Bible Verse:

2 Corinthians 1:20

Extra Bible verses:

Mark 4:35-41

Have you ever had someone make a commitment or promise to you and then break it? It's disappointing and can be very hurtful. You know who else makes promises? God.

Before Jesus got in the boat with the disciples and fell asleep and then calmed the storm, He made them a promise. (Remember that story? We find it in Mark 4) We are going to the other side. Maybe that didn't seem like a big deal at the time. But when the storm came, the disciples needed to be reminded of that promise. God gives us promises. Sometimes along the way those promises can seem far away. But God always keeps His promises. "For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so, through Him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God." (2 Corinthians 1:20 NIV) God has given us all promises to provide, protect, heal, and deliver. (And many others) He may have also given you some promises in your own life and they may not seem possible to reach but He will always come through. The wind and the waves are never more powerful than The One who created them. We are going to the other side.

Talk with God:

God, thank You for Your promises. Thank You that they are mine through Jesus and that they are all, "yes and amen". You will do what You say. You have always been faithful. As I face the different storms in my life, remind me again of Your great and precious promises. Help me to always trust You. I ask all this in the name of Jesus.

AT CAMP DEVO #3 "Faith is"

Bible verse:

Hebrews 11:1

Extra Bible verse:

Hebrews 11:6

What is faith? The world describes faith as the absence of evidence and logic. The Bible teaches the opposite. We need to have faith to believe that God is real and that He loves us. We need faith to believe that He is willing and able to meet every need.

Hebrews 11:1 teaches that faith is the substance of what we believe and then reminds us that many heroes in the Bible overcame because of the power of God working through people who have faith. With just a little faith we can see God do amazing things in and through us. Maybe you don't feel like your faith is that strong today. The good news is that God is strong. Just choose to believe for miracles and that God is going to move today, and when you see them watch your faith grow!

Talk with God:

Heavenly Father, I thank You that even a little bit of faith can move mountains. You have all power and there is no limit to Your goodness and love. You have no lack of resources. There is nothing You cannot do. I choose to trust You and put my faith in You. Help me to remember that even on my worst days when my faith may seem weak, that You, God, are forever strong. In Jesus' name I pray.

AT CAMP DEVO #4 "Time Travel"

Bible verse: Hebrews 13:8

Extra Bible verse: Psalm 62:8

Have you ever seen a good time travel movie or TV show? Maybe you've never even thought about it, but it's a concept that has been around for ages. What if we could suddenly appear in the past or the future? What would we do or say? It is, of course, science fiction. But time is a very real thing. Our entire lives are based on it.

We live within the restraints of time, God does not. He has created time and lives outside of it. He is eternal and unchanging. "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." (Hebrews 13:8 NIV) We can trust God's goodness and that He will always come through. He is never late. We may not be able to see what He is doing, but we can trust that He will never fail. We can pour out our hearts to Him at any time – day or night – and He will answer.

Talk with God:

God, I want to take some time right now to thank You that You are eternal and unchanging. Your love for me doesn't change. Your power doesn't change. The seasons of my life change, but You never do. You were, You are and You forever will be. Great is Your faithfulness. Help me to always remember this truth. It's in the name of Jesus, I pray all of this.

Bible verse: Galatians 5:1

Extra Bible verses: John 8:36

(Set free from bondage & sin. Romans 6:15-18)


Talk with God:





AT HOME DEVO #1 "The Power to Tell"

Bible verse: Acts 1:8

Extra Bible verse: Romans 8:11

Have you ever experienced a power outage at home or school? How about that sad moment when your phone's battery is dangerously low because you forgot your charger? We use power a lot in our modern world. Did you know that God has promised you power? (Cell phone battery not included) Romans 8 tells us that the same spirit that raised Christ from the dead lives in us. Why did God put His power in us?

In Acts 1:8 Jesus told His disciples that The Holy Spirit would come upon them to be His witnesses. They received power and went around doing miracles and boldly telling people about Jesus. That still happens today. The Holy Spirit heals, delivers, sets free, restores. He does this so that we can know God more fully and so that we will tell someone about it. Bible verse: 2 Kings 6

When hard times come it can be easy to give in to fear. One of the amazing things about God's grace is that He will send people into our lives that, at the moment we need, it will point us to Jesus.

When Elisha and his servant were about to be attacked the servant felt fear, but Elisha knew that God was with them. He prayed in 2 Kings 6 that God would open the eyes of his servant. The situation was bad. But Elisha knew that God was with them. When God opened the eyes of the servant, he, too, saw that God was protecting them. We all need people from time to time to help us really see the truth of what God is doing. Who can we be praying for today that God would open their eyes?

Talk with God:

AT HOME DEVO #3 "I've Got the Joy"

Bible verse: Psalm 16:11

Extra Bible verse: Nehemiah 8:10

If you ask a thousand people what does the word "joy" mean, most people would probably respond with the word, "happy". That is not entirely accurate. Joy is not happiness or good vibes. Happiness is great. Happiness is the result of your favorite sports team winning or eating a taco. Happiness, however, is temporary. It is entirely contingent upon circumstances.

Joy is knowing that God is for you. Joy is knowing that no matter what happens God is good. Joy doesn't come from anything the world has to offer; it comes from Jesus. Joy is a fruit of the Spirit. God produces it in us. Joy doesn't depend on our circumstances. The source of our joy is an eternal God who never runs out. Talk with God:

AT HOME DEVO #4 "Can't Find My Keys"

Bible verse: Romans 5:1-2

Extra Bible verse: Hebrews 4:16

Have you ever lost your keys to anything? Most of us probably have. Keys are important. Keys give us access to something. If you have been given access to somewhere, you have the right to be there.

Romans 5 teaches us that we have access through Christ to God. "Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God." (Romans 5:1-2)

We can confidently approach The Father. (Hebrews 4:16) We don't have to try hard to get God's approval. We don't have to work to earn His approval. We belong. We have access.

Talk with God:




