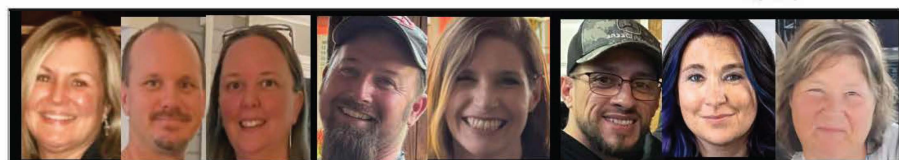

STUDENT GUIDELINES

The week at Encounter God's Presence camp is where God wants to radically change your life. We want to see you receive from God in a powerful way. So it is important, to please help us eliminate as many of the outside hindrances and distractions that you are probably faced with on an ongoing basis. It is our desire to provide a week that is an atmosphere saturated with the presence of God. In order for our camp to be successful, we have established the following guidelines. Please agree to the following before leaving home.

1. Come with a desire to hear from God and expect Him to impact your life.
2. Make sure your leader always knows where you are.
3. Be on time at each session, activity, and meal. Respect all curfews and get good sleep.
4. Abstain from bringing any electronic devices, and any questionable literature. Cell phones are a privilege and can only be used during certain times. They must be on silent during services and only used for Bible applications.
5. No water guns, water balloons, shaving cream fights, or “rough-housing” allowed. Disruptive, destructive, or dangerous behavior is prohibited. You will be responsible for replacement of anything you break.
6. There will be no leaving the campus or inviting guests without the approval of your youth pastor and camp leadership.
7. Armbands must be worn at all times for identification and security, and will be used as your meal ticket, so please keep them on your wrist.
8. This is a university campus with no housekeepers so clean your rooms before leaving each morning. Please make your bed, keep your clothes in or “near” your suitcase, keep all trash picked up, and keep the bathrooms free from clutter and the floors dry.
9. We challenge you to not allow romantic relationships or emotions to distract you from what God has for you.

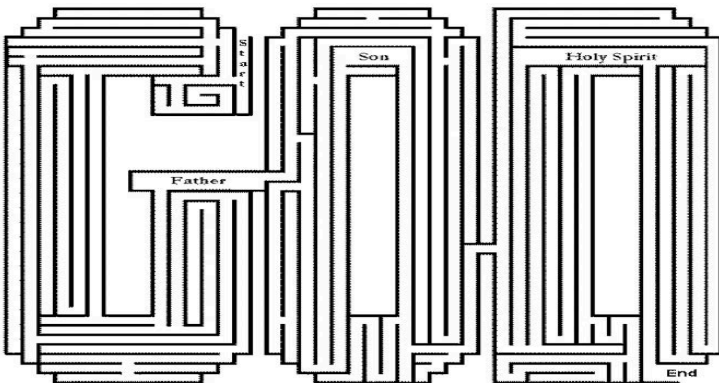

AT CAMP DEVO #1

"What is 'Therefore', there for?"

Bible verse:

Romans 12:1 "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God-this is your true and proper worship."

Ok, boys and girls, it's everybody's favorite time - Grammar time! We need to ask, what is "Therefore", there for? It's a conjunction, it links what has been said with what is about to be said. In the New Testament, the translation of this is used over 500x's. One such time is that Romans 12:1, "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God - this is your true and proper worship."

Paul had just spent the first 11 chapters sharing with us about God's grace and His heart for us. He shared how we've all sinned and need a Savior, how Jesus died on the cross for us and rose from the dead. How we should repent of our sins so we can be forgiven and brought back to right relationship with God. That we are accepted and loved far more than we could imagine and that we can be overcomers, all because of Jesus.

Therefore, (see how I use that word) our response should be to repent of our sins and surrender our lives to God. We should respond to the love of Jesus by loving Him and giving our whole life to Him because of who He is and what He's done. God has so much in store for you this week at EGP camp, let's start by fully surrendering everything over to Jesus.

Let's talk with God:

God, Thank You for Your love for me. Please forgive me for all my sins. Help me as I surrender my life over to You. I am grateful that You have brought me to EGP camp to impact my life. Please help me to get everything out of it that You have planned. I want to bring You all the glory. It's in Jesus' name I pray.

Want more? Read Romans 11:33-36 (God's mercy), John 3:16-17 (God's love), Ephesians 2:8-9 (grace)

Note- Strong's #3767: Therefore comes from the Greek word "oun" (pronounced oon) - apparently a primary word; (adverbially) certainly, or (conjunctionally) accordingly:--and (so, truly), but, now (then), so (likewise then), then, therefore, verily, wherefore.

AT CAMP DEVO #2

"How Bad Do Ya Want a Breakthrough?"

Bible Verse:

Mark 2:5, 9b "When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralyzed man, "Son, your sins are forgiven"....
"Get up, take your mat and walk".

In Mark 2, we have this amazing account where Jesus is teaching at a house and it gets so full that there is no room for anyone else. Suddenly, the roof opens. Next thing you know there is someone coming through the roof. 4 guys had brought their paralyzed friend to Jesus. Now Jesus didn't get upset with them and call him a "troublemaker" but He looked at the paralyzed man with love and called him, son.

When you or one of your friends needs a breakthrough, you must press into Jesus no matter what the cost. When we go to Jesus, He looks at us with love and He calls us His own. And, like this guy, He forgives and heals. He tells us to take up "our mat" and move on. What had once been our identity becomes part of our story. You are not what happened to you, you are a son or daughter. He sees you and He loves you. You surrender and put your faith in Jesus, you become a child of God.

Let's talk with God:

Jesus, thank You that You truly see me. You see everything, "the good, the bad and the ugly" and yet You still love me and when I repent, You forgive me. Please heal any hurt that is in my heart and help me be like those friends who love the people around me enough to bring them to You no matter what it takes. I pray all this in Jesus' name.

Want more? Read Mark 2:1-12 (full story), John 1:12 (children of God), Psalm 30:2 (healing).

AT CAMP DEVO #3

"I Got You"

Bible verse:

1 Thessalonians 5:11 "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing."

I don't know if you've been online lately, but in the midst of all the great videos of falling pandas and dance trends there are still a lot of people who are struggling with anxiety and many who are hurting. You don't have to look far to find people who need encouragement. We're everywhere.

Christians are The Body of Christ and have been designed for all of us to work together to build one another up. Think of how powerful your group of friends, your youth group could be if everyone encouraged one another regularly. Today be on a mission... find someone - or several someones - to encourage. There is power when we as Christians encourage one another. Go speak life to someone today, you have no idea the impact it can make!

Let's talk with God:

Holy Spirit, I ask You to open my eyes today to see those who really need encouraging. Please give me Your words to speak, whether it's a prophetic word, a Bible verse or just a compliment to encourage, help me have to have the right move and the courage to share it for Your glory not mine. I pray all this in Jesus' name.

Want more? Read Hebrews 10:24-25 (spur one another on), Proverbs 16:24 (kind words), Ephesians 4:29 (edifying speech)

AT CAMP DEVO #4

"How often do I have to pray?"

Bible Verse:

1 Thessalonians 5:17 "Pray Continually"

Ever have those times when prayer seems easy? Maybe there's times like that at camp. But sometimes prayer may feel like just this thing that we are supposed to do. It can become like an item to check off our to-do list. But prayer is not some obligation, it's how we can have an amazing relationship with God.

What does God get out of prayer? God is omniscient, meaning He knows everything. What could He possibly get out of you praying? You. He gets you. That's the whole point. He wants time with you. The King of the Universe wants to spend time with you and to have a real relationship with you.

He wants to partner with you to do great things, He wants to comfort you, heal you, encourage you, love you. As we surrender more and more to His will, we experience more freedom and we can be used to walk His Holy Spirit's power to see miracles and lives transformed.

Let's talk with God:

Jesus, thank You for creating prayer so that You and I can spend time together. I'm thankful that You listen to me and that You speak to me. Help me to always remember to wait and listen. Please teach me how prayer is a gift to build a relationship with You and it's also a powerful weapon against the enemy and strongholds that try to hinder our spiritual walk. I love You, God. I pray all this in Jesus' name.

Want more? Read Philippians 4:6-7 (prayer and peace), Psalm 145:18 (God is near), Colossians 4:2 (devoted to prayer).

AT CAMP DEVO #5

"Time To Go"

Bible verses:

Bible Verse: Matthew 28:19-20a "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you..."

After Jesus' death on the cross He was buried. On that third day, He rose in power and glory. He has conquered death and sin forever. This is The Gospel message. It is the basis for who Christians are as The Church. We are called to receive His love and forgiveness and then to be about the business of offering it to others.

The end of the book of Matthew shows Jesus' last documented words to His disciples. He told them to go and preach The Gospel and make disciples of all people. That call still stands. It's now our turn. We are called to share the message in our families, our friend group, our schools, our workplaces and all over the world. We all have a part to do. We have been called, it's time to go!

Let's talk with God:

God, we know Your Word tells us in Philemon 1:6, that we are called to be "active in sharing our faith." Please help me to have radical obedience when you lead me to share something with someone or if You call me to go out on an outreach or a mission trip. We ask that Your Holy Spirit would fill us with supernatural boldness to share about Your love & truth with others at every opportunity. I pray all this in Jesus' name.

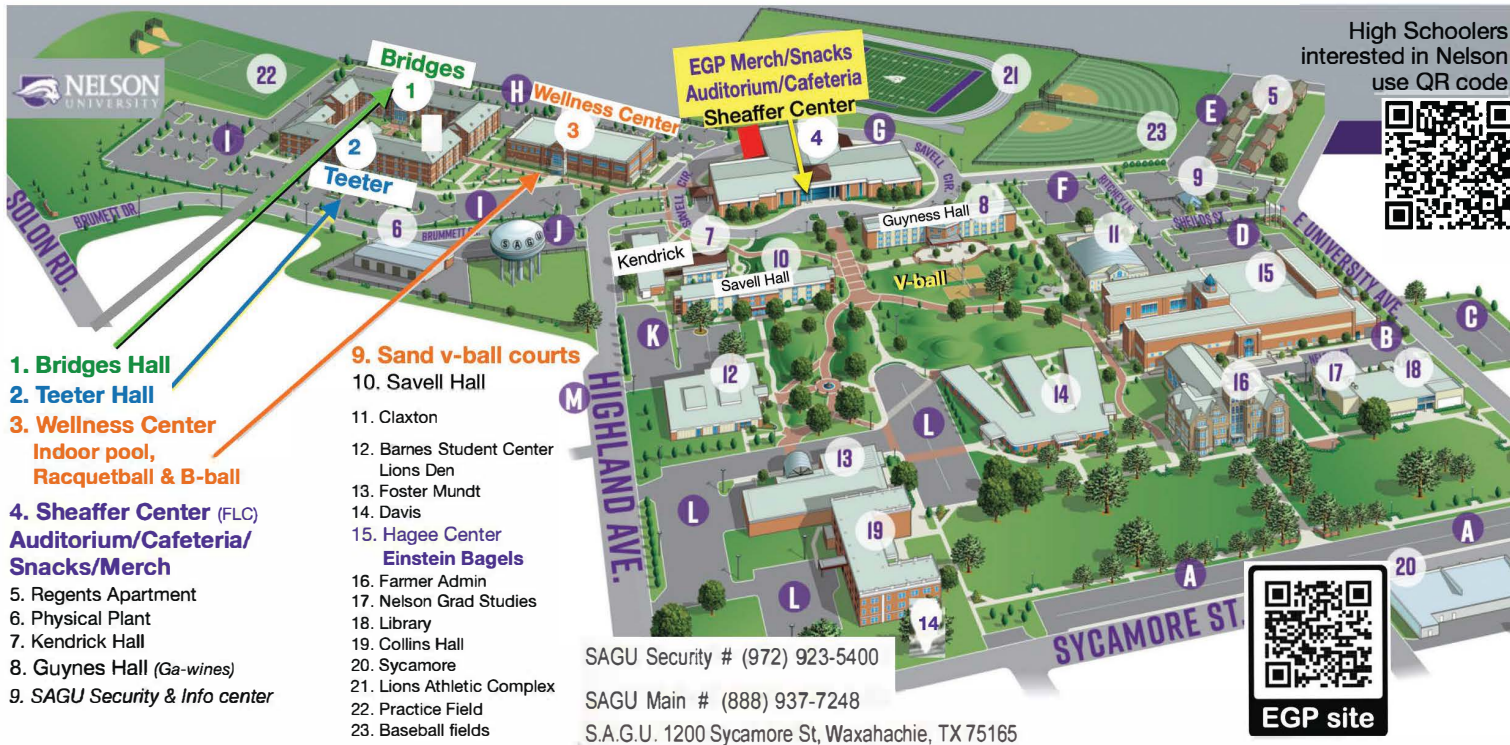
Want more? Read Acts 1:8 (power to witness), Mark 16:15 (preach The Gospel), 2 Timothy 4:2 (proclaim God's Word).

AT HOME DEVO #1

"The Better Thing"

Bible Verse:

Luke 10:42b, "... Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her."

In Luke 10, we find a great account involving Jesus and His disciples visiting with some friends. There were two sisters who lived there, Mary and Martha. While Jesus was teaching, Martha was serving those there. Mary stayed where she was and kept listening to Jesus, sitting at His feet. Martha got annoyed and asked Jesus to make Mary help. But Jesus lovingly pointed out that Mary had chosen the "better thing". Serving others is really important. It is being Christ-like. We should be looking for opportunities to serve each other. But it's not as near as important as sitting at the feet of Jesus. Why is that? It's about being in the presence of Jesus, where we are refreshed, strengthened, healed and learn truth. Now if we are always distracted with just miscellaneous things, we will get overwhelmed by all the things that need to be done. If our focus is Jesus, then we'll be overwhelmed by how good He is.

Let's talk with God:

God, Help me to learn to not be so busy and distracted with even good stuff to not make time for You. I want to take some time now to just wait and be refreshed in Your presence. And if You have anything You want to speak to me, I am listening. In Jesus' name I pray.

Want more? Read Luke 10:38-42, Psalm 27:4 (God's presence), John 15:4-5 (abiding). Reinforces focus on Jesus.

AT HOME DEVO #2

"We Are One"

Bible Verses:

Ephesians 4:4-6 "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all."

One of the beautiful things about EGP camp is that we come from different places. We have different backgrounds and traditions. We are different races. We are different generations like at your church. So what brings us together? Jesus.

When we focus on The One who brought us together then an amazing thing happens - unity. Our differences don't become things to divide us they become things to be celebrated. Each of us is a representation of Jesus. The enemy wants to divide us because he knows that there is world-changing power when the people of God move together as one!

Let's talk with God:

Heavenly Father, thank You for everyone that was at EGP camp. Thank You for every church and group and household that was represented. I pray they will all continue to grow closer to You and Your will. Please help each of us to see those around us the way You do. May Your Church be in unity as one! Moving in the gifts of Your Holy Spirit with Your fruits of Your Spirit to bring You glory. In Jesus' name I pray.

Romans 12:4-5 (one body). Emphasizes community.

AT HOME DEVO #3

"The Greatest of These is Love"

Bible Verse:

1 Corinthians 13:13 "And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love".

Faith is powerful. That's how we receive salvation. Jesus said that with just a little bit of faith we will see miracles. Hope is the expectation that God will bring good. It is powerful, too. Even so, 1 Corinthians teaches us that love is greater than both faith and hope.

Jesus said that the world will know that we belong to Him when we love each other the way He loves us. Think of the powerful, unrelenting love of God. Jesus wants us to love each other with that healthy and unselfish love. It's not always easy. It goes against culture. When we do, it is a powerful testimony to the love and power of God. Today's mission is love as you have been loved. Good news. The one who calls us to love each other provides the power for us to do so.

Let's talk with God:

Jesus, thank You for Your love for me. No matter what I do or say, You still love me. You always have and You always will. It's Your love and kindness that leads me to true repentance and surrendering more to You. I'm asking that Your Holy Spirit would empower me to love those around me, even those who I find difficult to love. Please help me to love like You do. It's in Jesus' name I pray.

Want more? Read all 1 Corinthians 13, Hebrews 11:1, Romans 5:5, Eph. 2:8-9, John 13:34-35 (love one another)

AT HOME DEVO #4

“Why You So Worried?”

Bible Verses:

Matthew 6:25-33

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus is teaching us how to really live. In chapter 6, He makes the statement “Do not worry”. Anybody else find that really hard to not worry a lot of times? Spoiler alert, He knows how we can struggle with that.

Our Heavenly Father knows everything that we need. The same God that feeds and clothes nature will take care of you. You are more valuable than all of nature. He already knows what you need, but part of our relationship is to voice our needs and heart to Him. When you ask, know that you are asking a loving Father.

Want more? Read Matthew 6:25-33, Philippians 4:19 (God’s provision), Psalm 23:1 (my Shepherd), 1 Peter 5:7 (cast anxieties). Addresses anxieties.

AT HOME DEVO #5

"To Study, To Do and To Teach"

Bible Verse:

Ezra 7:10 "For Ezra had devoted himself to the study and observance of the Law of the Lord, and to teaching its decrees and laws in Israel."

Ezra devoted himself to studying God's Word, doing what it says and teaching it to others. We should do the same. First, we commit ourselves to studying the Word of God. We should make it a habit to read the Bible regularly. The more we read God's Word, the more it changes us.

Secondly, we can't just read it, we have to do what it says. The more we study God's Word and begin to walk it out in our lives, the more we become like Jesus. It changes us and that changes the world around us. Finally, we need to commit to sharing The Word with others. We are constantly surrounded by opportunities to share who God is and what He's done.

Let's talk with God:

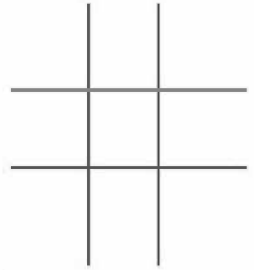
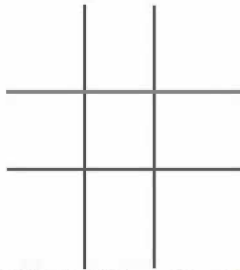
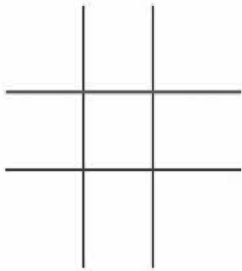
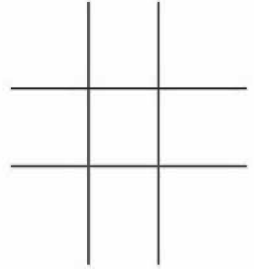
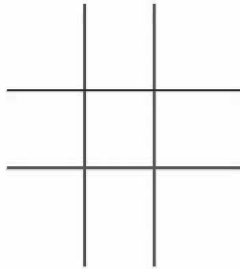
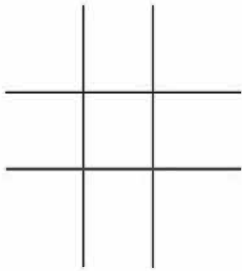
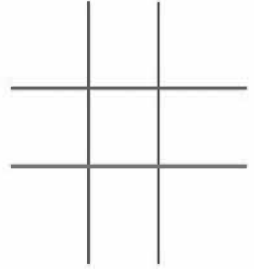
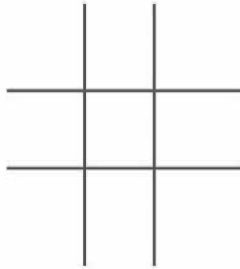
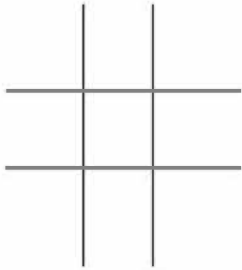
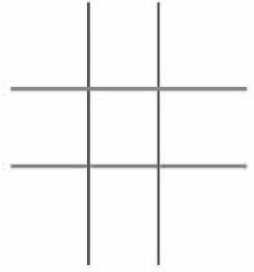
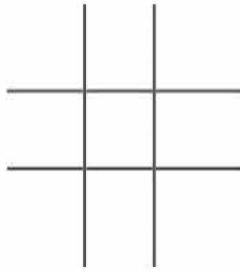
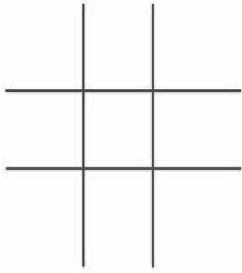
